Abu Dhabi, UAE August 15 2011: The jury is still out as to who could take the Winners' Cup in this years Play for Life Ramadan Football Tournament as sixteen of Abu Dhabi's top organisations battled it out for the second night running.

It was a high scoring evening all round, with every match seeing the winning team place at least three goals and above in the back of the net.

Mubadala A, the top goal scoring team in round one, maintained good form and beat Abu Dhabi's Planning Council (UPC) 3-1. Meanwhile, Yabsat played the night's early top score, netting six goals against Masdar's one (6-1) in the first game of the evening. Etihad Rail followed track to round off the evening again scoring six goals against CCAD's 1 (6-1).

Meanwhile, Mubadala B turned the tables on a thrashing from ADAT yesterday (1-3) to also score a high five against DKA 2 (5-2). Meanwhile, venue host ADNEC also bagged five, with contender Waha Capital failing to hit one home for the second night running (5-0).

The Tournament official, Captain Ahmad Al-Issawi noted that the calibre of play was particularly high, as was the enthusiasm of the teams: "I am called to coordinate many tournaments and timekeeping is always big issue. But not for Play for Life this year. I am so pleased to see teams arrive on time, and eager to get on the pitch and play a very good game of football."

Play for Life is part of 'Diabetes-Knowledge-Action', the nationwide public health awareness campaign under the patronage of Her Highness Sheikha Fatima bint Mubarak.

The Tournament takes on a round robin format. The seven-a-side teams are arranged into four groups of four teams playing matches of 15 minutes each way.

The final takes place on Thursday. There are three trophies waiting to be taken home – one for the tournament winner, and one each for the first and second runners up. The 60 players representing the three final teams – each team can register up to 20 men - will each receive a Play for Life medal!
