Abu Dhabi, UAE August 16 2011: Eight teams are through to the quarter finals of ICLDC's Play for Life Ramadan Football Tournament (later today, August 17), with the Group D Etihad Rail alongside Group C's Masdar and Yashat joining the Mubadala duo to form a hot line-up of strongly-placed contenders for the Winners' Cup.

ADAT also comes through as a potential cup holder, with a three in a row win under their belt after knocking out the public health awareness campaign's namesake, Diabetes-Knowledge-Action (3-0).

Round three brought in a couple of tie scores, with two out of eight matches ending in a draw. Meanwhile, ICLDC's own team entry had an easy first win as the warm favourite Injazat placed a 'no show'.

The quarter finals sees the Group A teams of ADAT and Mubadala B pitched against ADNEC and Etihad Rail in Group D, respectively. YAHSAT, a Group C team drew against B's SEHA, and ADS (B) will take on Mubadala A (C).

The semi-finals and the final will be played tomorrow (Thursday) at the bespoke pitches at Abu Dhabi National Exhibition Centre. For the second year running, ADNEC is transformed by the organiser's ICLDC to hold two air-conditioned seven-a-side football pitches.

ICLDC's spokesperson, Carol Sansour Dabdoub said that the event has been very well attended and is on track to meet and even beat the targeted crowds of 3,500 over the five nights of play: "For the first three nights we have welcomed more than 1,900 people to the Tournament," she said.

The arena has been designed with comfortable team facilities, chill out areas and lots of fun-filled activities to entertain the whole family, as they too learn how regular exercise means healthy living.



Play for Life is part of 'Diabetes-Knowledge-Action', the nationwide public health awareness campaign under the patronage of Her Highness Sheikha Fatima bint Mubarak.

The Tournament takes on a round robin format, with the seven-a-side teams playing matches of 15 minutes each way.

There are three trophies waiting to be taken home – one for the tournament winner, and one each for the first and second runners up.
